PETITION TO ESTABLISH CONSERVANCY DISTRICT

Comes now the **Town of Battle Ground** and files its **Petition to Establish a Conservancy District** and in support of this Petition, says the following:

1. That the name of the proposed district shall be "The Battle Ground Conservancy District".
2. That the territory to be included in the district shall be the Town of Battle Ground.
3. That the purpose for which this district is to be established is to provide water supply, including treatment and distribution for domestic, industrial and public use.
4. That it is necessary to accomplish the above purpose in order to insure safe water and adequate distribution of treated water to the people of the district by providing for necessary improvements to the existing water system in Battle Ground, **including the construction of a water storage tower.**
5. That the creation of the district will be conducive to the public health, safety, and welfare.
6. **That this Petition is conditioned upon a grant of State funds from the Department of Natural Resources Flood Control Revolving Fund.**
7. That conditions attached to State aid are acceptable if the State government should offer a grant of funds.
8. That the uneven number of directors to serve on the Board of the Conservancy District shall be five, and the

proposed District shall be divided into five areas congruent with the five wards of the Town of Battle Ground.

9. That the maintenance and operation of the works of improvement necessary to accomplish the purposes of the Conservancy District shall be paid for solely by annual levy of special benefits tax plus revenue plus State or Federal funds.
